This pathway allows students to build foundation knowledge and specific skills to work in the fields of hospitality, tourism and recreation in Plumas County and other beautiful places, with a focus on the growing field of outdoor recreational tourism. They will gain skills in leadership, cooperation, outdoor skills and communication. Students will then have opportunities to dive more deeply into specific trainings related to outdoor trip planning and management, recreation events, and other hospitality and tourism fields. Plumas Charter School CTE Pathways are a 20-credit course sequence including; introduction, concentration, and capstone courses.
