In this pathway, students have the opportunity to gain knowledge about patient care within the health science and medical technology industry. The standards for the patient care pathway apply to occupations or functions involved in the prevention, treatment, and management of illness and the preservation of mental and physical well-being through the services offered by the medical and allied health professions. The standards specify the knowledge and skills needed by professional and technical personnel pursuing careers in this pathway. Plumas Charter School CTE Pathways are a 20-credit course sequence including; introduction, concentration, and capstone courses.
